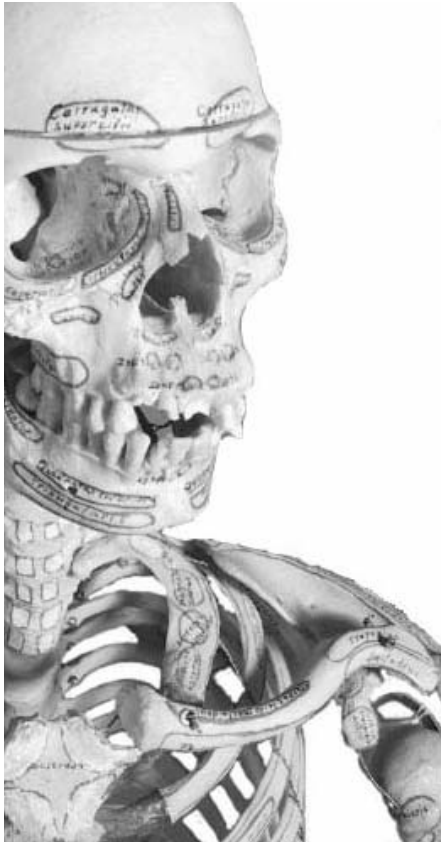


## WANT SOMETHING DIFFERENT FOR YOUR INTERNSHIP OR FIELD PLACEMENT?
